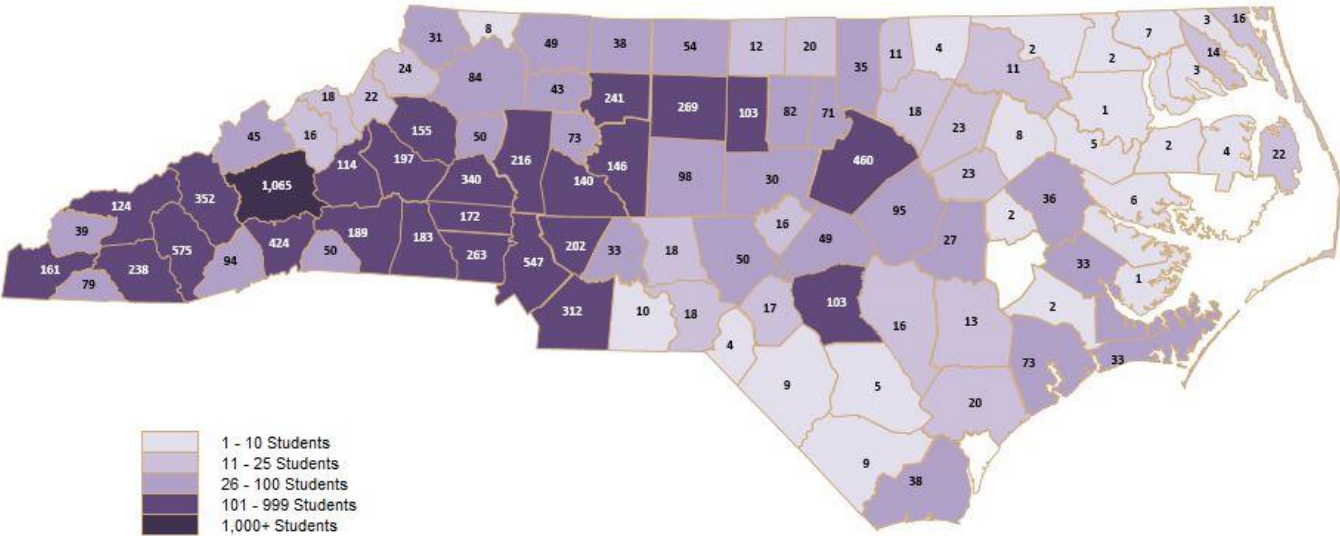

# Geographic Distribution of Students

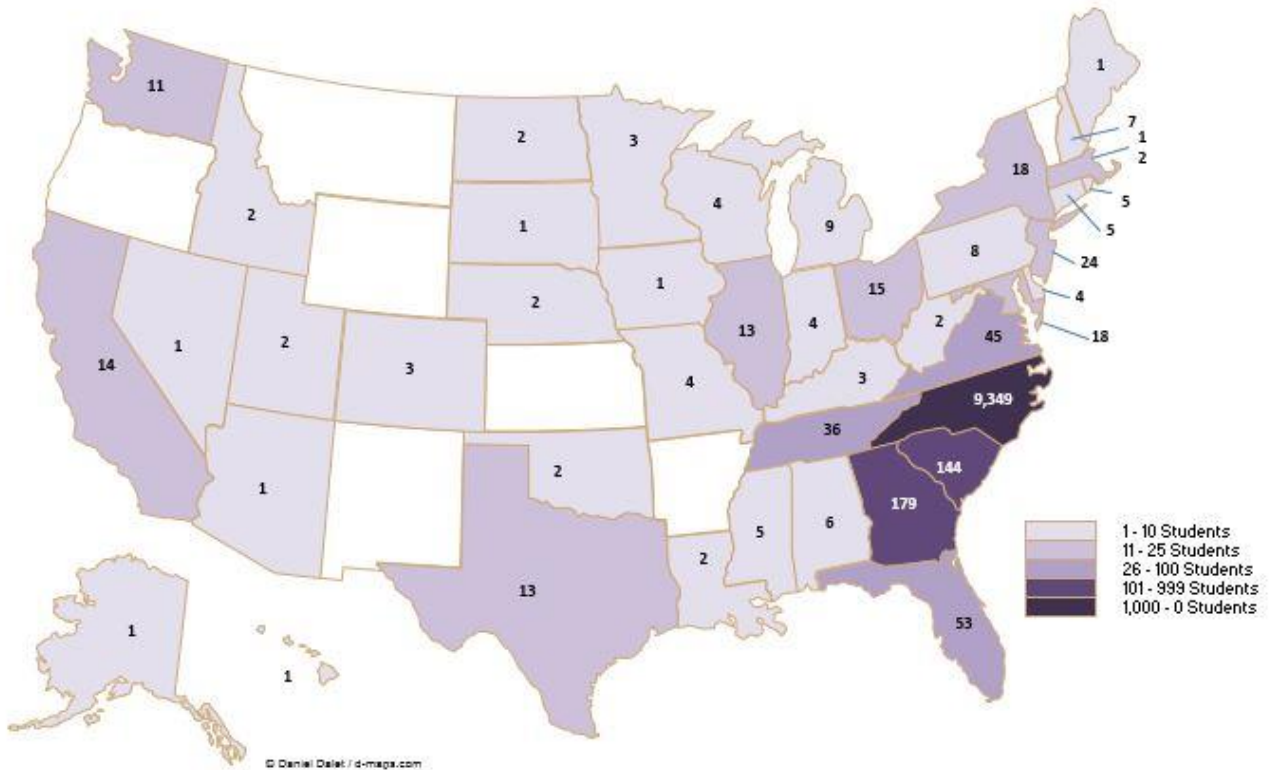

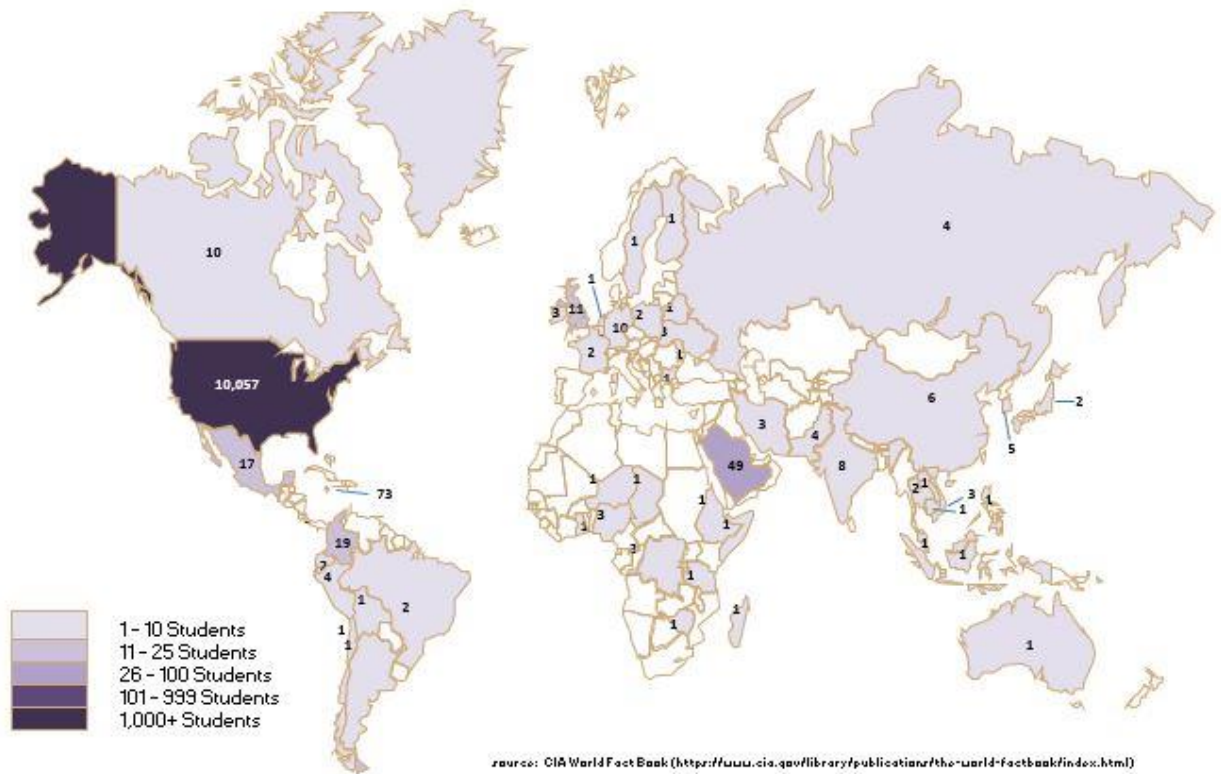
## Total Enrollment by State
