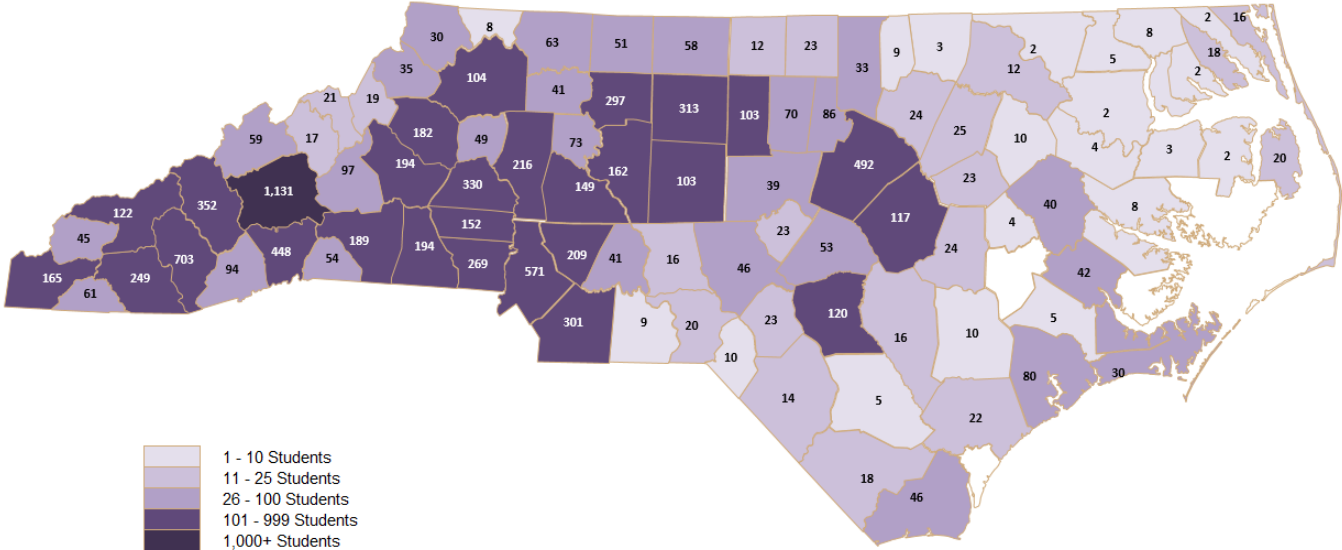

Geographic Distribution of Students

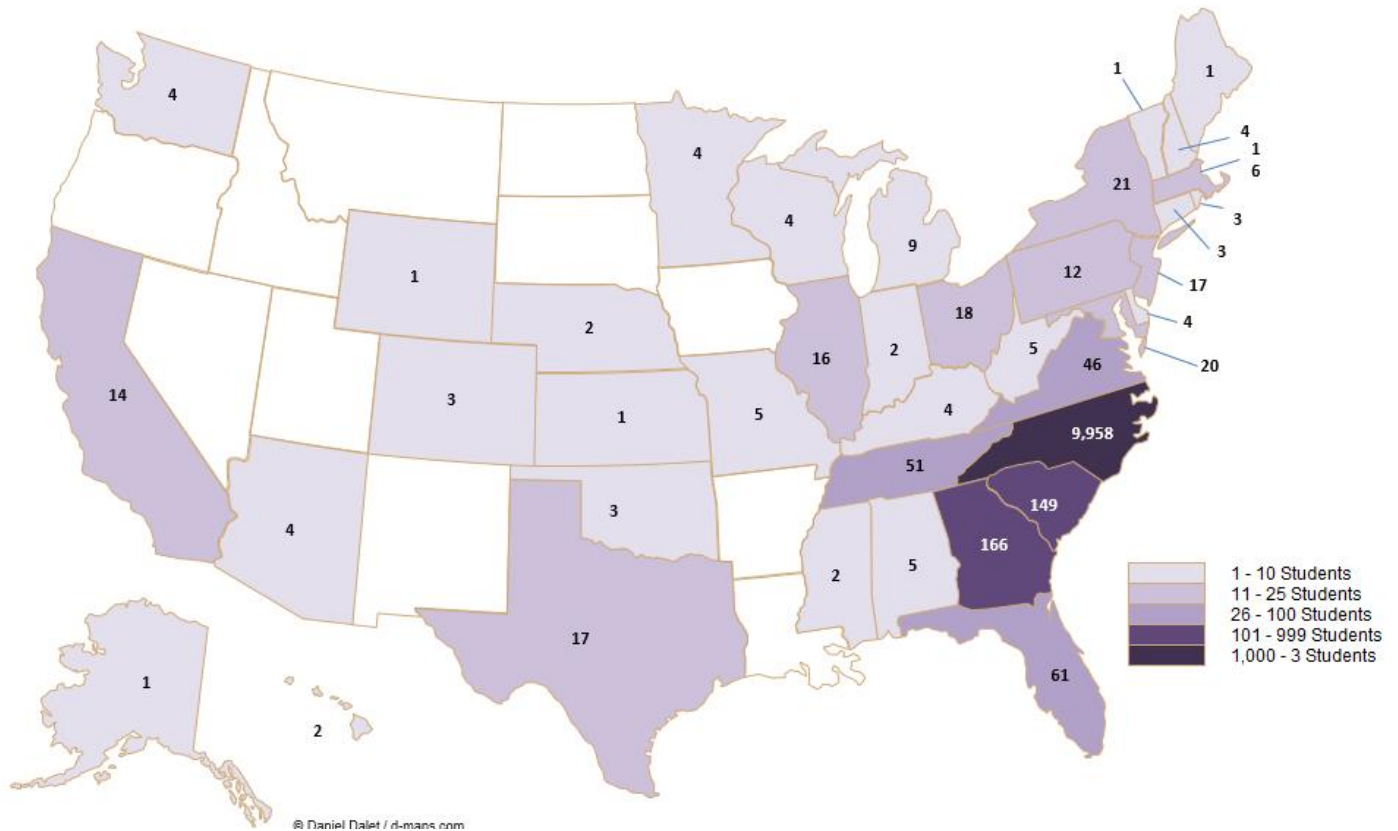
In State Total Enrollment

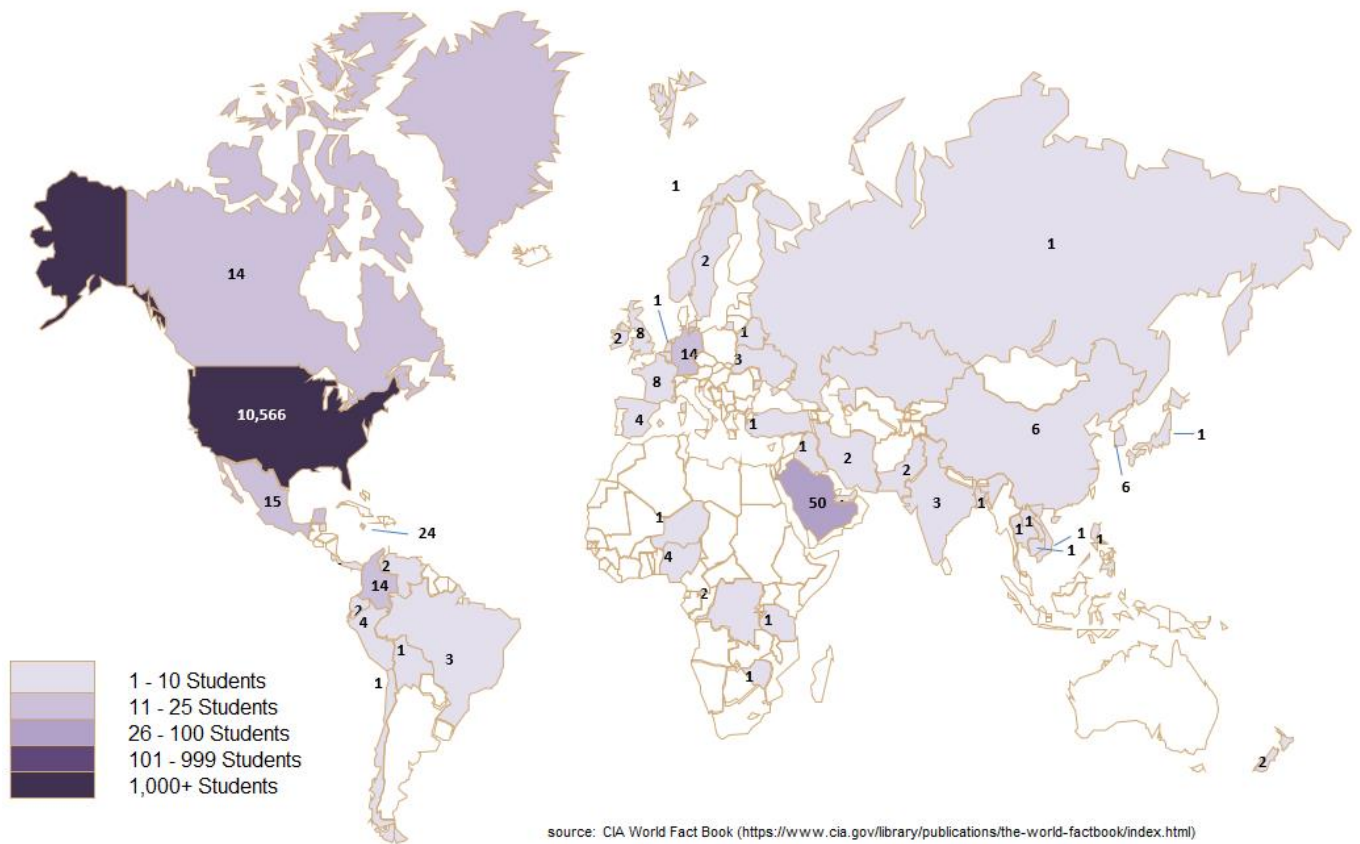
Total Enrollment by State
