**PROGRAM NOTES:** (1) SEIL majors are required to complete 50 hours of Service Learning prior to Intern II. (2) SEIL courses are only offered during the semester indicated with the exception of SPED 240 and internships. (3) Students must complete one field experience in a culturally diverse setting in EDCI 201, SPED 240, Intern I, or Intern II. (4) Upon satisfactory completion of program and requisite licensure exams, students in the SEIL: Elementary Education concentration will be eligible to apply for NC licensure in both K-12 Special Education: General Curriculum and K-6 Elementary Education.
